Hérault, pays d'Oc, France

GRAPE VARIETY:

100% Carignan

TASTING NOTES:

Mont Gravet Red is cherry red in color with an abundance of red berries with vanilla hints on the nose. Full-flavored and easy-drinking.

TECHNICAL NOTES:

Alcohol 12.5% | PH: 3.56

Acidity: 3.5 g/L

Tartric Acidity: 3.02 g/L

VINEYARD:

This delicious red wine is produced from old vine Carignan (between 60 and 80 years old) grown in vineyards high in the hills of the Hérault region of the Languedoc in Southwest France. The calcareous soils in Hérault is rich in nutrients and minerals that are found in this part of France and is ideal for cultivating Carignan.

WINEMAKING:

Although this wine is made from an old traditional grape variety, the winemaking process is done in a modern style. The grapes are destemmed before they are slowly fermented at a controlled temperature of 25°C. The wine is then aged in stainless steel tanks for 6 months.

TASTING:

Mont Gravet Red is a beautiful cherry red in color and has a suggestion of black cherries and raspberries on the nose. It is rich in fruit flavors but fresh and easy-drinking. Best served slightly chilled.

FOOD MATCH:

The perfect barbecue wine but great with grilled vegetables, pasta, beef stews and other red meats.
